PUBLIC QUESTION(S)

PROPOSITION TO EXTEND A ONE-HALF (1/2) PERCENT SPECIAL COUNTY RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX (SALES TAX) FOR MENTAL HEALTH PURPOSES

TO PAY FOR MENTAL HEALTH PURPOSES, SHALL THE COUNTY OF WINNEBAGO BE AUTHORIZED TO EXTEND AN INCREASE ON ITS SHARE OF LOCAL SALES TAXES BY ONE-HALF (1/2) PERCENT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE (5) YEARS, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026?

1. This would mean that a consumer would pay an additional \$0.50 in sales tax for every \$100 of tangible personal property bought at retail.
2. If extended, the additional tax would cease being collected at the end of five (5) years, if not terminated earlier by a vote of the County Board.
